

AUGUST 14, 2017 MONTHLY MEETING

TOWNSHIP OF HARRISON

The regular monthly meeting for the Township of Harrison was held on Monday, August 14, 2017 at Northland Church. Notice of the meeting was posted as required by law. Chairman Lee Halverson called the meeting to order at 6:30 P.M. Present at the meeting were Bob Kasson, Jon Ann Kasson, Bob Opperman, Fran Moen, Mike Schultz, Dan Dowell, Casey and Leslie Beyersdorf.

The Clerk's minutes from the previous meeting were read. A motion was made by Bob Kasson and second by Bob Opperman to accept the minutes as read. Motion carried.

The Treasurer's report was given. The beginning balance on July 31, 2017 was \$74,468.60. Deposits for the month totaled \$29,580.80. The checks and withdrawals totaled \$49,845.05. The balance on July 31, 2017 was \$54,204.35. The money market account had a beginning balance of \$71,228.86 and the amount of interest paid to the account was \$29.28 leaving and ending balance of \$71,258.14.

OLD BUSINESS: There is not a law concerning vehicles parking on or around bridges therefore signs will not be posted by Town bridges at this time.

NEW BUSINESS: Casey Beyersdorf who has been hired as the Waupaca County Highway Commissioner gave the board information concerning his qualifications for the job and information on the services that are available to the Townships of Waupaca through the Highway Department. He also answered questions from the Board. A motion was made by Bob Opperman and second by Bob Kasson to sign a Memorandum of Understanding for Statewide Wisvote System between the Town of Harrison and the County of Waupaca. The agreement is valid for the year 2018. Motion carried. Calls received during the month were discussed by the Board. A motion was made by Lee Halverson and second by Bob Kasson to adjourn the meeting at 8:00 P.M. Motion carried.
