

## **MINUTES OF A PUBLIC HEARING**

**APRIL 10, 2017**

### **TOWNSHIP OF HARRISON**

A Public Hearing was held in the Township of Harrison at Northland Church on Monday, April 10, 2017. The landowners on Reimer Road have requested that the Town Board abandon the road.

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Lee Halverson at 6:00 P.M. Present at the meeting were Gretchen & Fred Heinritz, Tom Opperman, Dan Dowell, Bob Opperman, Bob Kasson, Jon Ann Kasson, and Fran Moen.

All notifications and requirements have been met by the landowners and the Town Board. The reasons for the landowners request is the road is a dead end and is used for such things as late night parties, illegal burning pits, and dumping trash. It is not an access road to the DNR land that is located there.

An easement agreement has been signed by the land Owners granting each other access to the road. They will place a gate at the end of the road, but emergency vehicles will have access to the road.

A motion was made by Bob Opperman and second by Bob Kasson to grant the land owners request that that the Township abandon Reimer Road. Motion carried. Those voting yes were (3) Bob Kasson, Bob Opperman and Lee Halverson. Those voting no were 0.

A motion was made by Lee Halverson and second by Bob Kasson to adjourn the meeting at 6:15 P.M. Motion carried.
