

## **JANUARY 14, 2019 MONTHLY MEETING**

### **TOWN OF HARRISON**

The regular monthly meeting for the Town of Harrison was held on Monday, January 14, 2019 at Northland Church. Notice of the meeting was posted as required by law. Chairman Lee Halverson called the meeting to order at 6:30 P.M. Present at the meeting were Bob Kasson, Bob Opperman, Fran Moen, Jon Ann Kasson, Dan Dowell, Mike Schultz, Jan & Lee Lehr, Dave Loken, Patricia Johnson, Diane Erickson, Diane Troast, John Phillips, and Jordon Lashua.

The Clerk's minutes from the previous meeting were read. A motion was made by Bob Opperman and second by Bob Kasson to accept the minutes as read. Motion carried.

The Treasurer's report was presented to the Board. The beginning balance in the checking account on December 1, 2018 was \$28,172.89. Deposits for the month totaled \$438,851.51. The amount of the checks and withdrawal was \$18,095.29. The ending balance on December 31, 2018 was \$448,929.11. The beginning balance in the money market account was \$21,754.13. Interest collected for the month was \$7.39 leaving a balance in the account of \$21,761.52.

#### **OLD BUSINESS: NONE**

**NEW BUSINESS:** Dave Loken representing Rural Mutual Insurance Company went over the coverages and premiums on our Town policy. A few changes were made to the amount of coverages on personal property belonging to the Town of Harrison that are stored and used in the homes of the town officials.

A motion was made by Bob Opperman and second by Bob Kasson to contract with the County to do repairs in the summer of 2019 to bridges on Drake, Comet and Ness roads. The cost is estimated to be \$12,500.00.

The Board presented to those in attendance information they have gathered on the matter of allowing ATV/UTV's access to our town roads. Comments and opinions were given to the board from those present at the meeting. The Board put together an ordinance and it will be presented at a Public Hearing to be held on Monday, February 11, 2019 at 6.00 P.M. in the basement at

Northland Church. The Ordinance will be displayed on the Town web-site prior to the Public Hearing.

Any Town resident who needs sand this winter season may pick some up from a pile that has been left in the yard at Northland Church.

A motion was made by Bob Opperman and second by Bob Kasson to adjourn the meeting at 8:30 P.M. Motion carried.
