

## **JULY 8, 2019 MONTHLY MEETING**

### **TOWN OF HARRISON**

The regular monthly meeting for the Town on Harrison was held on Monday, July 8, 2019 at Northland Church. Notice of the meeting was posted as required by law. Chairman Dean Lashua called the meeting to order at 6:30 P.M. Present at the meeting were Dan Dowell, Paul Miller, Bob Kasson, Bob Opperman, Diane Troast, John Phillips, Jon Ann Kasson, Ann Cassamassa, Mike Schultz, and Fran Moen.

The Clerk's minutes from the previous meeting were read. A motion was made by Ann Cassamassa and second by Mike Schultz to accept the minutes as read. Motion carried.

The Treasurer's report was given. The beginning balance on June 1, 2019 was \$87,132.25. The total of deposits for the month was \$1,939.21 and the total of checks and withdrawals for the month totaled \$16,934.28. The ending balance on June 30, 2019 was \$72,137.18. The beginning balance in the Money Market account was \$21,797.55. Interest collected for the month was \$6.69 leaving a balance in the account of \$21,804.24.

**OLD BUSINESS:** The route signs allowing the use of ATV/UTV's within the Township have been installed.

**NEW BUSINESS:** Scott Construction has completed the summer road work. Grass cutting on town roads will take place in July. The Rosholt School District is in the process of forming an Advisory Committee to gather information on the possibility of having a day care center in the Rosholt School. They are looking for up to 3 people per township to serve on the committee. Anyone interested in serving on this committee should contact the Rosholt School District or Dean Lashua. Calls and concerns received by the Board during the month were discussed. A motion was made by Mike Schultz and second by Ann Cassamassa to adjourn the meeting at 7:00 P.M. Motion carried.
