

**JUNE 12, 2017 MONTHLY MEETING**  
**TOWNSHIP OF HARRISON**

The regular monthly meeting for the Township of Harrison was held on Monday, June 12, 2017 at Northland Church. Notice of the meeting was posted as required by law. Chairman Lee Halverson called the meeting to order at 6:30 P.M. Present at the meeting were Mike & Becky Schultz, Dan Dowell, Bob Kasson, Jon Ann Kasson, Bob Opperman and Fran Moen.

The Clerk's minutes from the previous meeting were read. A motion was made by Bob Kasson and second by Bob Opperman to accept the minutes as read. Motion carried.

The Treasurer's report was given. The beginning balance on May 1, 2017 was \$109,879.03. The total of deposits for the month was \$.86. The total of the amount of checks written was \$27,899.46. The ending balance on May 31, 2017 was \$81,980.43. The beginning balance in the Money Market account was \$71,168.39. Interest collected for the month of May was \$27.30 leaving a balance in the account of \$71,195.69.

**OLD BUSINESS: NONE**

**NEW BUSINESS:** A motion was made by Lee Halverson and second by Bob Opperman to grant a bartender license to Cynthia Berry, Michele Preston, and Denise Olson. Motion carried.

Bob Kasson researched various ordinances in the state regarding the placement of sexual predators in our communities and townships. The board held a discussion on the effect such an ordinance would have on our Township. At the present time the state is also addressing this problem. The board decided to delay any action on this item until more information can be obtained.

Mike Schutz and Dan Dowell gave the board a report on the Land Use Permits given out since the beginning of the year. Bridge work in the Township will begin after July, 1, 2017. Scott Construction has completed the wedging of our roads. Crack filling and chip sealing will also be done. Lashua Construction will be grading our roads. The Wisconsin DOT has scheduled to pave and widen the curves on State Highway 49 in 2020. The road will remain open during the project. Calls received during the month were discussed by the board. A motion was made by Bob Kasson and second by Lee Halverson to adjourn the meeting at 7:15 P.M. Motion carried.
