

MARCH 11, 2019 MONTHLY MINUTES

TOWN OF HARRISON

The regular monthly meeting for the Town of Harrison was held on Monday, March 11, 2019 at Northland Church. Notice of the meeting was posted as required by law. Chairman Lee Halverson called the meeting to order at 6:30 P.M. Present at the meeting were Dean & Dawn Lashua, Rose Troast, Patricia Johnson, Diane Erickson, Michael Schultz, Dan Dowell, Bob Opperman, Bob Kasson, Jon Ann Kasson, and Fran Moen.

The Clerk's minutes from the previous meeting were read. Two corrections were made to the minutes. The balance in the Money Market account on January 31, 2019 was \$21768.91 and the ATV trails should be called ATV routes. A motion was made by Bob Opperman and second by Bob Kasson to accept the minutes with the two corrections. Motion carried.

The Treasure's report was presented to the Board. The beginning balance on February 1, 2019 was \$290,170.16. Deposits for the month totaled \$198,262.28. The total of the checks written and withdrawals was \$352,100.91. The beginning balance in the Money Market account was \$21768.91. Interest collected for the month was \$6.68 leaving a balance on February 28, 2019 of \$21,775.59.
