

NOVEMBER 12, 2018 MONTHLY MEETING TOWN OF HARRISON

The regular monthly meeting for the Town of Harrison was held on Monday, November 13, 2018 at Northland Church. Notice of the meeting was posted as required by law. Chairman Lee Halverson called the meeting to order at 6:30 P.M. The Clerk's minutes from the previous meeting were read. A motion was made by Bob Opperman and second by Bob Kasson to accept the minutes as read. Motion carried.

The Treasurer's report was given. The beginning balance on October 1, 2018 was \$21,759.00. Deposits for the month totaled \$26,564.41. The amount of the checks and withdrawal was \$16,992.00. The ending balance on October 31, 2018 was \$31,331.41. The Money Market account had a beginning balance of \$21,739.12. Interest collected for the month was \$7.86 leaving a balance in the account of \$21,746.98.

NEW BUSINESS: Discussion on the effects and liabilities to the Town of Harrison if an Ordinance was passed allowing All-Terrain/Utility Terrain vehicles to run on the Town roads was held. Mr. Gene Goody was present to answer questions and explain the standard ordinance that other Townships have been using. Public comments were heard by the Board and a discussion on whether to adopt this ordinance to allow town roads to be used for these vehicles will be put on the agenda for December 2018. The Northwest First Responders gave the Board their annual report for the year. They have gained a new EMT for the First Responders and spent \$7000.00 this year for new communications equipment. A motion was made by Lee Halverson and second by Bob

Kasson to give the Northwest First Responders \$2000.00. Motion carried. Calls and concerns received by the Board during the month were discussed. A motion was made by Bob Opperman and second by Bob Kasson to adjourn the meeting at 7:30 P.M. Motion carried.
