

## **OCTOBER 14, 2019 MONTHLY MEETING**

### **TOWN OF HARRISON**

The regular monthly meeting for the Town of Harrison was held on Monday, October 14, 2019 at Northland Church. Notice of the meeting was posted as required by law. Present at the meeting were Diane Erickson, Patricia Johnson, Rod Gill, Bob Opperman, Dan Dowell, Jon Ann Kasson, Fran Moen and Ann Cassamassa. The meeting was called to order by Supervisor Mike Schultz.

The Clerk's minutes from the previous meeting were read. A motion was made by Ann Cassamassa and second by Mike Schultz to accept the minutes as read. Motion carried.

The Treasurer's report was given. The beginning balance on September 1, 2019 was \$43,382.84. Deposits for the month totaled \$1,711.41. The total amount of expenditures for the month was \$6,369.50. The ending balance on September 30, 2019 was \$38,724.75. The Money Market account had a beginning balance of \$21,819.30. Interest collected for the month was \$7.41 leaving an ending balance in the account of \$21,826.71.

#### **OLD BUSINESS: NONE**

**NEW BUSINESS:** The Town of Harrison will not receive any money from FEMA as the expenses incurred for cleanup from the summer storm did not meet the minimum amount FEMA requires to be eligible for reimbursement. The Iola Fire Departments budget for the year 2020 will remain the same as 2019. The Iola Ambulance will be increase their budget by \$10,000.00. The Harrison Town Board will meet at 6:30 P.M. on Tuesday, October 22, 2019 at Northland Church to prepare the 2020 Town budget. The Public Hearing for the 2020 Town Budget will be held at 6:30 P.M. on Monday, November 11, 2019

at Northland Church. Two land use permits were issued in the month of September. Calls and concerns received during the month were discussed by the Board. A motion was made by Ann Cassamassa and second by Mike Schultz to adjourn the meeting at 7:05 P.M. Motion carried.
