

RESOLUTION # 107-2015

**ADOPTING THE WAUPACA COUNTY ALL HAZARDS MITIGATION PLAN**

**FISCAL IMPACT:** None

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Harrison recognizes the threat that natural hazards pose to people and property; and

**WHEREAS**, undertaking hazard mitigation actions before disasters occur will reduce the potential for harm to people and property and save tax payer dollars; and

**WHEREAS**, an adopted all hazards mitigation plan is required by FEMA as a condition of future grant funding for mitigation projects; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Harrison participated jointly in the planning process with Waupaca County and the other local units of government within the County to prepare an All Hazards Mitigation Plan, which was made available for review via a Legal Notice and a copy of which will reside permanently in the Waupaca County Emergency Management Office;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Town Board of the Town of Harrison adopts the Waupaca County All Hazards Mitigation Plan as an official plan; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Waupaca County Emergency Management Department will submit, on behalf of the Town, the adopted All Hazards Mitigation Plan to Wisconsin Emergency Management and Federal Emergency Management Agency officials for final review and approval. Minor changes been made upon advice from Wisconsin Emergency Management and Federal Emergency Management Agency will not require re-adopting this resolution.
