

SEPTEMBER 9, 2019 MONTHLY MEETING

TOWN OF HARRISON

The regular monthly meeting for the Town of Harrison was held on Monday, September 9, 2019 at Northland Church. Notice of the meeting was posted as required by law. Present at the meeting were Bob Opperman, Diane Troast, John Phillips, Bob Kasson, Jon Ann Kasson, Ann Cassamassa, Mike Schultz and Fran Moen. Chairman Dean Lashua called the meeting to order at 6:30 P.M.

The Clerk's minutes from the previous meeting were read. A motion was made by Ann Cassamassa and second by Mike Schultz to accept the minutes as read. Motion carried.

The Treasurer's report was given. The beginning balance on August 1, 2019 was \$27,598.50. Deposits for the month totaled \$31,686.55. The total amount of expenditures for the month was \$15,902.21, the ending balance in the account on August 31, 2019 was \$43,382.84. The Money Market account had a beginning balance of \$21,812.13. Interest collected for the month was \$7.17 leaving an ending balance of \$21,819.30.

OLD BUSINESS: The registered letters sent to Mr. John Grover and Mr. Mark Kraklow were received by both parties. Mark Kraklow informed the board that he is in the process constructing a new fence that separates the properties. After the fence is complete members of the board will review the structure. If the fence meets with the board's approval they will consider the matter resolved.

NEW BUSINESS: At the quarterly fire meeting they have requested the purchase of a new fire truck to update the trucks they have. The request was tabled until information is gathered and alternatives to the purchase of a truck have been discussed. Calls and

concerns received during the month were discussed by the Board. A motion was made by Mike Schultz and second by Ann Cassamassa to adjourn the meeting at 7:15 P.M. Motion carried.
